
#### Policy changes facing installers

- There are now more than 3 million rooftop solar customers in the U.S.
- That number is projected to double by 2025.
- Solar owners are more civically engaged and active than non-solar customers.
- Solar owners are politically diverse.

## How to empower your customer to become an advocate



#### Education



Education should start before your customer signs a contract. It's valuable for solar customers to understand the policies that underpin their ability to go solar. This way, when their solar rights come under attack, they're ready to fight back.

## Policies solar customers should understand:

- Net metering
- Permitting/interconnection rules
- HOA restrictions



#### Activation



Getting solar panels installed is just the beginning. Solar owners have a powerful story to share with decision-makers.

#### Ways to get your customers involved:

- Write a letter to the editor
- Join other solar supporters to meet with their elected officials to create and support pro-solar policy
- Attend a rally to show their support for solar energy.



#### Communication



As an installer, you know the best ways to reach your customers. Is it a text, a phone call, or an email? It's how you sell panels and it's how you can build solar activists.

#### How to communicate effectively:

- Have a clear ask.
- Tell your customers exactly what they can to do support solar.
- Make your customer the hero. Use language that makes them the star.
